Additional observations around the spill point: **OIL BUBBLES WERE NOTICED INTERNALLY AT THE POSITION OF THE MISSING CAMERON CONTROL UNIT ON THE WELL 7L ARM (BEING THE SPILL POINT). THE BONNET GASKET AND ONE OF THE FLANGE BOLTS FOR THE MISSING CCU ON WELL 7L WAS FOUND ON THE WELL HEAD GRATING AS AT TIME OF INVESTIGATION. OIL STAINS WERE OBSERVED ON THE BODY OF THE**

WELL HEAD BUT ONLY LIGHT OIL SHEEN WAS OBSERVED AS SPILL TO THE ENVIRONMENT (ON WATER). ALSO, THE CCU ON THE WELL 7S ARM WITH TWO BOLTS WERE OBSERVED MISSING, BUT WITH NO OBSERVABLE SPILL IMPACT.

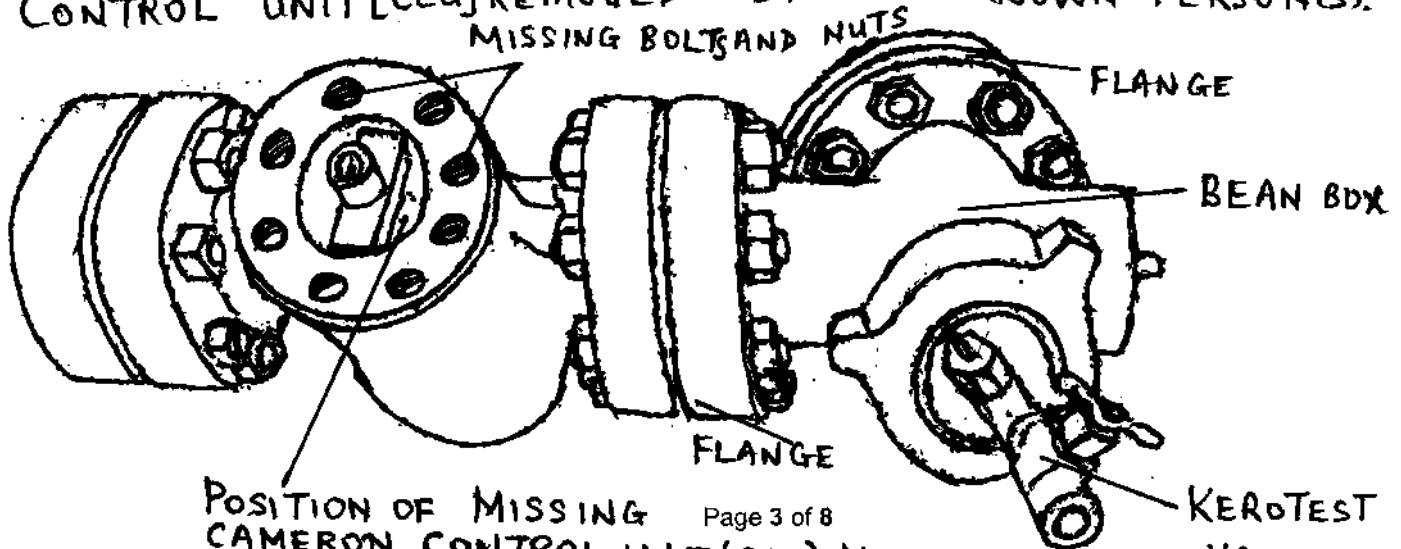
